

Terms and Conditions for WKHT of Hawaii Education Award Application

Applicant must be:

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| 1. | A current qualified active member (at least one year) of the WKHT of Hawaii Society. Activity fees must be in good standing for the semester the student is applying. For example, 2019 activity fees will cover Spring 2019 and Fall 2019 Education Award applications. |
| 2. | A current resident of the State of Hawaii |
| 3. | A current <u>full-time</u> undergraduate and/or graduate student in an accredited junior college, community college, four-year college/university or vocational school who has completed a term. Vocational students who are compensated will be ineligible for the awards. |

Applicant must:

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| 1. | Demonstrate academic ability, interest in the WKHT Education Award, and prove leadership ability in relation to school, community and/or in support of the WKHT of Hawaii mission. |
| 2. | Participate and/or plan one WKHT community activity, or general public <u>community activity within the past six (6) months prior to submission of an application.</u> |
| 3. | Students living on the mainland must provide written documentation of a school or community service activity they participated in. Please specifically describe what did you contributed to the public community activity and what you learned from that experience.

General membership meetings are excluded as an activity. |
| 4. | Maintain a satisfactory term Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 for the previously completed semester (or equivalent).

The term GPA must be based on a full-time credit load as noted below; <ul style="list-style-type: none">- undergraduates must have a minimum of 12 semester/quarter credits per semester.- students at a university with a quarter schedule are eligible for the maximum of 2 education awards per year as determined by WKHT of Hawaii.- graduate students, i.e. Master and Doctorate students must provide the full-time credit load policy from the university/college they are attending <i>along with their application.</i> |
| 5. | Along with your application, activity checklist, please provide a copy of your official grade slip for the semester completed and the following below: <ul style="list-style-type: none">. Submit a one page letter of intent which explains applicant's goal(s) for:<ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Higher education and what this award means to the applicant.b. * New applicants must provide a clear, passport sized headshot photo. |

However, first consideration will be given to those applicants who meet the criteria and have not received a WKHT Education Award. * Failure to not meet all requirements and not submit all required documents by the deadline, will result in being ineligible for an award for that semester.</p> <p>WKHT Education Award shall be limited to an applicant for only one (1) undergraduate degree or equivalent, only one (1) master's degree and only one (1) doctorate degree.</p> <p>A.) Applicants for the WKHT Education Award who are completing a second bachelor's degree are eligible to receive financial assistance ONLY if the applicant's first bachelor's degree was completed WITHOUT financial support from WKHT.</p> <p>Final selection of awardees is the sole responsibility of the WKHT Education Award Committee and final approval from the Executive Board.</p> <p>The Education Award will be paid out to the recipient receiving the award and will be presented to him or her at the general meeting. A representative may be sent if recipient is unable to attend. Otherwise, check will be mailed to the Hawaii address as listed on the application.</p> <p>Upon receipt of the Education Award, awardees are to submit a letter of acknowledgement within 30 days to the Chair of the Education Award Committee preferably by email. If the committee does not receive a letter of acknowledgement, the student shall not be eligible for the next semester's (or equivalent) Education Award.</p> <p>Deadline: All applications and all related documents must be received by the Education Awards Chairperson no later than 6/30 or 12/30 of the applicable year.</p>
